After seventeen months, Q was given custody back and was in search of a safe, affordable place for them both to live. She recently came up for a project based unit in Falmouth and was accepted. Her rent share is very affordable on her income, and she just needed help with move-in costs. We assisted Q with \$405 to cover her security deposit through Private Prevention funds.
