COMING UP NEXT MONTH

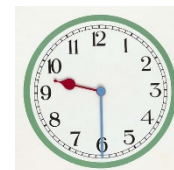


Please save the date of Tuesday, November 28th. It's time to decorate the church again! We will set up and decorate six trees to enhance the beauty of our church for the
