D-YECH FOOD CARDS

Another reason why buying D-YECH Food Cards is important: The N Family was referred to HAC when their electricity had been shut off on a Friday. Upon reviewing their situation, they had never needed to access any funding available to them because they had always been able to sustain their day to day living by working hard week to week. After O went out on unpaid maternity leave, she found it difficult to find another job that offset daycare costs for their infant. After receiving fuel assistance, this family went into a repayment plan that was above what their means were to pay it back effectively. O had started working at the end of last month, and had not received her first check in time to make a payment, and they were in default of their repayment arrangement with Eversource. Consequently, their power was turned off putting their house at risk. We utilized \$453.88 of Private Prevention funds to pay the minimum required to restore their service and continue their payment plan.
