EMERGENCY CONTACT FORMS

Completed forms are kept in a locked closet by the Deacons, but are accessible to the Deacons, the pastor, and the office administrator.

D-YECH FOOD CARDS

Another reason why buying D-YECH Food Cards is important: T has lived in his Cape apartment for 6 ½ years with his wife and 3 children (15, 7 and 2). T has worked full time at the same business for 6 years until last month. He was laid off, and his company allowed him to collect unemployment. He notified leased housing of his income decrease, but it was not recalculated in time for September's rent. T has never accessed any funds and didn't want to even come ask for help. He had an interview the morning we met with him for a local competitor's company doing the same job overnight trucking. We spoke to the property manager who spoke very highly of him and his family. Looking at his ledger, it reflects month after month of rent being paid on time and in full. We utilized \$500 of Private Prevention funds to bridge the gap for his September rent and maintain his voucher.
