She works full time at a dentist office, and until December 24, she worked part-time at a seasonal t-shirt shop as a second job. Her income decreased, her daughter came home from college over the break, and she missed work because of a civil case she was involved in as the Plaintiff. It was during our meeting that she mentioned something about receiving a letter from HAC regarding a voucher. I stressed the importance of following through with the meetings and gathering of documents if it meant getting a Section 8. She has since been issued a Section 8 voucher and is hoping to lease up in place. She needs to be current with her landlord in order for her to be able to use her voucher there. We utilized \$500 out of Private Prevention Funds so she can stay in her home and utilize her voucher.
