### **D-YECH FOOD CARDS**

Another reason why buying D-YECH Food Cards is important! M came to HAC seeking assistance with her rent arrearage. She was not eligible for state funds and owed a substantial amount of money. She had medical issues that made it difficult to do the work she has always done. Her oldest daughter works full time and is helping as much as she can. We explained to M that with so much money owed, she would have to seek assistance from other local agencies in order to avoid eviction. She was able to secure funding elsewhere and returned back to HAC with the ability to pay more of her arrearage than previously. We utilized Private Prevention to assist with the remainder of her back rent (\$500) in the hopes of keeping this family housed.

### **MATTRESSES+ SALE!**

Timothy Curran is a member of the DY band. They are holding a mattress fundraiser on Saturday, June 2 at DY high school gym. The gym will be set up like a mattress showroom with two dozen name brand beds available at savings up to 50% off retail (financing is available).
