GUEST PREACHER – LYLE ASHBY

Lyle, who grew up in Washington, D.C, attended Oberlin college, Union theological Seminary in New York City, and received his master’s degree in theology from Columbia University. He began his ministry in the Methodist Church in 1963 as an associate pastor on Long Island. His first appointment in the Methodist Church was as the Pastor of Trinity Methodist Church in Frederick, Maryland. His ministry in Frederick was followed by a long period of non-traditional ministry in the public and private sectors in New York City and Hartford, Connecticut where he was a city planner and manager of real estate developments. During a great part of his time in Connecticut, Lyle also worked with the West Hartford Pastoral Counseling Center working with individuals and groups, and in the training of people preparing to be counselors. Lyle was called to the East Haddam, CT. U.C.C. in 1996 and retired from the church to Cape Cod in 2005.

S came to HAC seeking assistance with one month's rent.

She works full time at a dentist office, and until December 24, she worked part-time at a seasonal t-shirt shop as a second job. Her income decreased, her daughter came home from college over the break, and she missed work because of a civil case in which she was the Plaintiff.

It was during our meeting that she mentioned something about receiving a letter from HAC regarding a voucher. I stressed the importance of following through with the meetings and gathering of documents if it meant getting a Section 8. She has since been issued a Section 8 voucher and is hoping to stay in place. She needs to be current with her landlord in order for her to be able to use her voucher there. We utilized \$500 out of Private Prevention Funds so she can stay in her home and utilize her voucher.
