SAVE THE DATE – SEPT. 9!



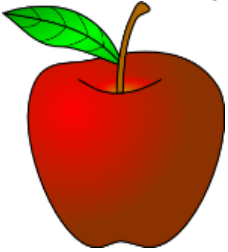
