

They left all belongings behind except for clothing. *K* was able to secure housing through a housing authority but had no funds remaining for any belongings. We were able to utilize supplies at HAC to help supply their new home with kitchen items and towels, but *K* and her daughter had no furniture. Private funds were used to purchase beds for *K* and her daughter so they could utilize their secured home.
