F, her husband, and their 11 year old child came to HAC for assistance with mortgage arrears. F had been on medical leave with no pay due to a medical condition, and her husband was concurrently unable to work due to some mental health difficulties. They became in arrears due to lack of income over a couple of months, and we were able to coordinate with other funding sources while using private funds to catch them up and avoid foreclosure. This family has never accessed HAC funding before. Both adults have received job offers and should have no problem remaining current moving forward.
